We hope that you enjoy this year's event. Please see inside for a full timetable of Ride to the Wall events and activities.

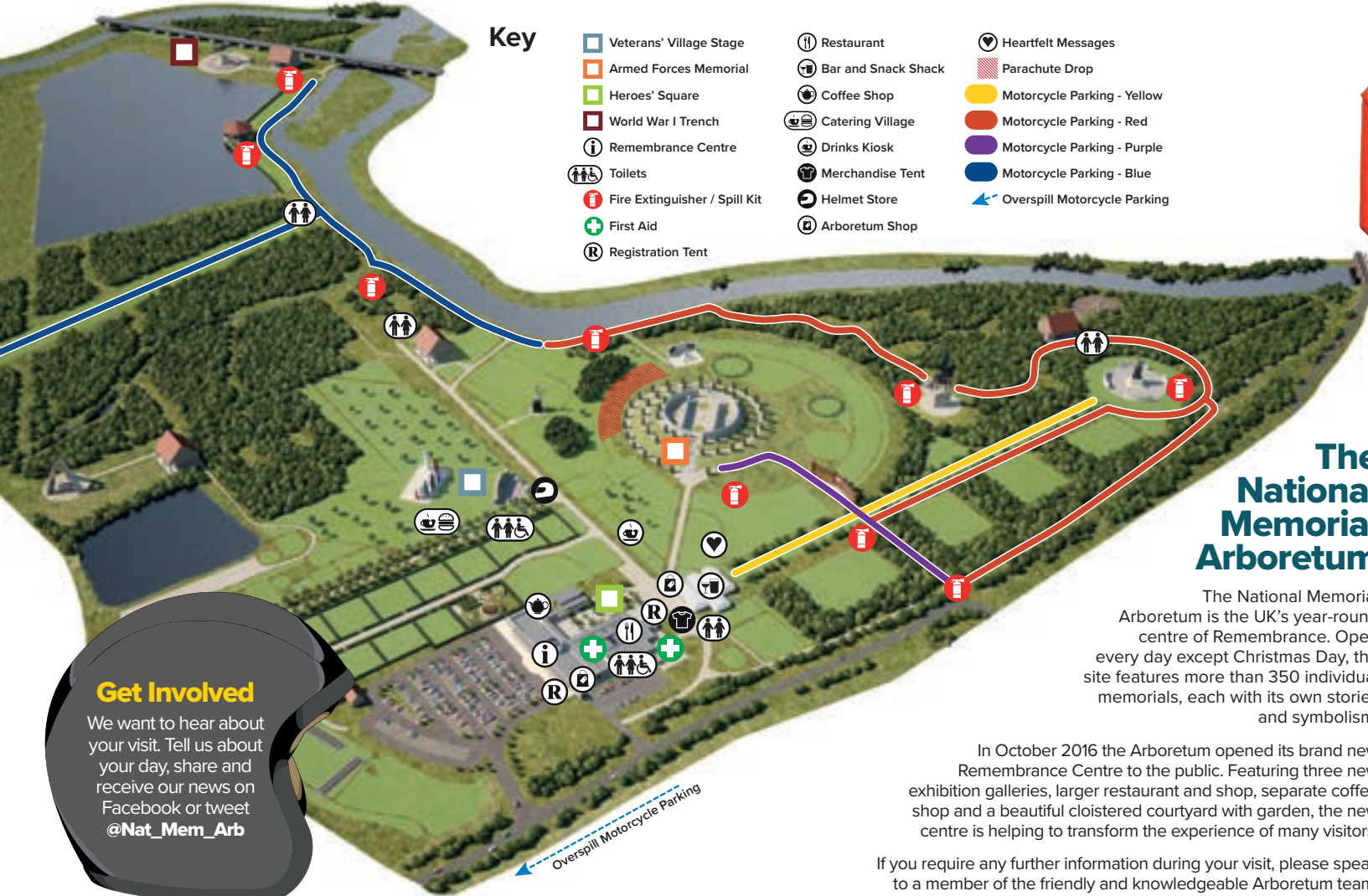

The National Memorial Arboretum

The National Memorial Arboretum is the UK's year-round centre of Remembrance. Open every day except Christmas Day, the site features more than 350 individual memorials, each with its own stories and symbolism.

In October 2016 the Arboretum opened its brand new Remembrance Centre to the public. Featuring three new exhibition galleries, larger restaurant and shop, separate coffee shop and a beautiful cloistered courtyard with garden, the new centre is helping to transform the experience of many visitors.
